GLOBAL HEALTH PHILANTHROPIST SEES AI AS A GAME-CHANGER

Original tech titan Bill Gates is Express Adda guest today

IN AN ERA where technology shapes our conversations and Big Tech wields unprecedented political influence in the US, what lies ahead? How will the deepening connections between Silicon Valley and Washington, D.C., reshape the global landscape? Meanwhile, Trump's trade wars have unsettled markets, and the trajectory of AI remains uncertain.

In short, unpredictability is the new norm. And who better than Bill Gates, the original tech visionary, to help us navigate this turbulence, and tell us about what we should truly be concerned or unconcerned about. Gates, the Microsoft co-founder-turned-global health philanthropist, will be the guest at Express Adda in Mumbai on Thursday. He will be in conversation with Anant Goenka, Executive Director, The Indian Express Group.

This is Gates's third visit to India in three years. He will also discuss his new book, 'Source Code: My Beginnings', which traces his childhood, his early vision for the future and his passion for new ideas. The man who brought computers into people's homes sees artificial intelligence as the second major technological revolution, the first being the graphical user interface that paved the way for

modern operating systems. Gates, specifically, sees AI as a game-changer in healthcare, capable of bridging critical gaps — from helping health workers screen for diseases in remote areas to fast-tracking groundbreaking research. And he

believes India is at the forefront of innovation. On his website, he writes that India is a place where "big challenges meet even bigger ambitions, and where innovation is transforming lives at an incredible scale". He highlights India's

remarkable achievements in public health — from eradicating polio and preventing HIV to expanding childhood immunisation. Now, with cutting-edge diagnostics and AI-run tools, the country is accelerating efforts to eliminate tuberculosis.

But India's influence extends beyond healthcare. Gates sees it as a global leader in digital transformation, pointing to innovations like Aadhaar and the digital payments system as examples of how technology is reshaping everyday life on an unprecedented scale.

Since stepping down from Microsoft's board in 2020, Gates has dedicated himself fully to philanthropy. In India, the Gates Foundation has been working on public health, particularly maternal and newborn health, immunisation, sanitation, agriculture and the girl child in collaboration with the government, businesses and other organisations.

Express Adda is a series of informal interactions with newsmakers in the presence of a select audience. Past guests include Nobel Laureate Amartya Sen, external affairs minister S Jaishankar, finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman, His Holiness the Dalai Lama, actors Pankaj Tripathi and Tabu, oncologist and writer Siddhartha Mukherjee, musician TM Krishna, ecologist Romulus Whitaker and writer William Dalrymple.

NASA astronauts 'Butch and Suni' return to Earth after nine months

NASA ASTRONAUTS BUTCH Wilmore and Suni Williams returned to Earth in a SpaceX capsule on Tuesday with a soft splashdown off Florida's coast, nine months after their faulty Boeing Starliner craft upended what was to be a week-long stay on the International Space Station. Their return caps a protracted space mission that was fraught with uncertainty and technical troubles, turning a rare instance of NASA's contingency planning — and the latest failures of Starliner — into a global and political spectacle.

The two veteran NASA astronauts and retired US Navy test pilots had launched into space as Starliner's first crew in June for what was expected to be an eight-day test mission. But issues with Starliner's propulsion system led to cascading delays to their return home, culminating in a NASA decision to fold them into its crew rotation schedule and return them on a SpaceX craft this year.

On Tuesday morning, Wilmore and Williams strapped inside their Crew Dragon spacecraft along with two other astronauts and undocked from the ISS to embark on a 17-hour trip to Earth. The four-person crew, formally part of NASA's Crew-9 astronaut rotation mission, plunged through Earth's atmosphere to a splashdown, some 50 miles off Florida's Gulf Coast under clear skies. "What a ride," NASA astronaut Nick Hague, the Crew-9 mission commander, told mission control moments after splashing down.

The astronauts will be flown on a NASA plane to their crew quarters at the Johnson Space Center in Houston for a few days of routine health checks before NASA flight surgeons say they can go home to their families. "They will get some well-deserved time off, well-deserved time with their families," NASA's commercial crew programme chief Steve Stich said.

US President Donald Trump, upon taking office in January, called for a quicker return of Wilmore and Williams and alleged that former President Joe Biden "abandoned" them.

NASA said the two had to remain on the ISS to maintain adequate staffing levels and it did not have the budget or the operational need to send a dedicated rescue spacecraft. Crew Dragon flights cost between \$100 million to \$150 million.

Eight-day mission turned into 286-day ordeal for Williams

AN EIGHT-DAY MISSION for NASA astronaut Sunita Williams to the International Space Station (ISS) turned out to be a challenge of a lifetime as problems cropped up on her Boeing space flight that stretched her stay in orbit to over nine months.

A former US Navy captain, Williams, 59, was born to a Gujarati father Deepak Pandya hailing from Jhulasan in Mehsana district and Slovenian mother Ursuline Bonnie Pandya on September 19, 1965, in Euclid, Ohio. Proud of her multicultural roots, Williams has carried symbols of her heritage to space, including samosas, a Slovenian flag and Ganesha idol during previous missions.

Hailing Williams, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said, "Space exploration is about pushing the limits of human potential, daring to dream, and having the courage to turn those dreams into reality. Sunita Williams, a trailblazer and an icon, has exemplified this spirit throughout her career."

President Droupadi Murmu also greeted Williams and her

fellow astronauts. "Congratulations to the entire team behind the safe return! India's daughter Sunita Williams and her fellow astronauts have inspired everyone with their perseverance and never-say-die spirit."

"Their historic journey is a tale of determination, teamwork and extraordinary courage. I salute their unwavering resolve and wish them excellent

health!" Murmu posted on X. On her third mission to the ISS in June last year along with Wilmore, Williams also created history by setting a record for the most time spent in space-walking by a woman. She now has 62 hours and nine minutes of extra-vehicular activity, surpassing former astronaut Peggy Whitson's record of 60 hours and 21 minutes.

GCCs see 10% salary jump in a year

GLOBAL CAPABILITY CENTRES (GCCs) in the country are poised for a 9.8% salary growth over the next 12 months, as organisations adapt to evolving talent demands and navigate macroeconomic challenges, a report said on Wednesday.

In India, GCCs are seen as the top payers, outpacing traditional IT services in pay parity and growth, India's Talent Take-off - The GCC 4.0 Story report by digital talent solutions provider NLB Services said.

"With India hosting over 55% of the world's GCCs and projected to reach a market size of \$110 billion by 2030, these centres have become critical nodes for organisations seeking agility, cost efficiency and access

to a vast talent pool," NLB Services CEO Sachin Alug said.

However, he said, despite this strong momentum, gender-based disparities still require attention, with women earning approximately 75-85% of male salaries on average, a gap which further widens at senior positions. "In financial services, we're witnessing a transitional

shift, with roles like risk analysts, compliance associates, senior risk managers, FRM leads, heads of compliance and global finance directors, commanding salaries in the range of over ₹6-90 LPA," Alug said.

The report is based on insights from 207 GCC decision-makers across six major cities and 10 diverse sectors. It further

revealed that GCCs are seen as top payers in Hyderabad (19%) and Mumbai (19%), especially in IT software and consulting (22%) and banking/financial services (18%). Meanwhile, Delhi/NCR (21%) and Bengaluru (24%) showed strong salary competitiveness, with notable parity in telecom and internet services (12%).

India's online gaming sector likely to cross \$9 bn by 2029

THE ONLINE GAMING sector in India is expected to grow by over two-fold to \$9.1 billion by 2029, largely dominated by real money games, a joint report by real money gaming platform WinZO Games and the Interactive Entertainment and Innovation Council (IEIC) said on Wednesday.

The report said India's online gaming market revenue was \$3.7 billion in 2024, with the real money gaming segment accounting for around 86% market share.

"The industry has the potential to unlock up to \$63 billion in investor value by 2029. We remain committed to shaping India into a global gaming powerhouse," WinZO co-founder Paavan Nanda said. According to the report, India is home to 591 million

gamers — about 20% of the world's total, around 11.2 billion mobile game app downloads with strong emerging alternatives to Google Playstore, and around 1,900 gaming companies, employing 130,000 lakh highly skilled professionals.

The sector has received \$3 billion in FDI, out of which 85% of the FDI was channelled to the Pay-to-Play segment. "Real money gaming continues to dominate, contributing 85.7% of the sector's revenue, valued at \$3.2 billion, and growing at 18% in 2024," the report said. The share of RMG is expected to moderate to 80% by 2029, and the share of non-RMG is expected to increase from 14.3% to 20%.

India's only publicly-listed gaming company Nazara commands the highest premium among the globally-listed gaming peers.

भारताच्या कसोटी आणि एकदिवसीय संघाचा कर्णधार रोहित शर्मा, ट्वेन्टी-२० संघाचा कर्णधार सूर्यकुमार यादव, तसेच कसोटी सामन्यांत भारताचे नेतृत्व केलेला जसप्रीत बुमरा असे अनुभवी खेळाडू मुंबईच्या संघात आहेत. गतहंगामात या चौघांमध्ये सारे आलबेल नसल्याच्या चर्चा रंगल्या होत्या. गेल्या ‘आयपीएल’पूर्वी झालेल्या मुंबई संघाच्या पत्रकार परिषदेत हार्दिकने कर्णधारपद आणि रोहितबरोबरचे संबंध यावरील प्रश्नांची उत्तरे देणे टाळले होते. मात्र, यंदा चित्र पूर्णपणे वेगळे होते.

भारतीय क्रिकेट नियामक मंडळाने (बीसीसीआय) बंगळूर येथील राष्ट्रीय क्रिकेट अकादमीचे (एनसीए) सेंटर ऑफ एक्सलन्स (सीओई) असे नामकरण केले असले, तरी खेळाडूंच्या दुखापतींच्या व्यवस्थापनाचा प्रश्न अजून दूर झालेला नाही.

भारताचा आघाडीचा गोलंदाज जसप्रीत बुमरा असो किंवा देशातील सर्वाधिक वेगाने चेंडू टाकणारा गोलंदाज मयांक यादव, ‘सीओई’ने त्यांच्या दुखापतीचे स्वरूप आणि त्यांना पूर्णपणे तंदुरुस्त होण्यासाठी लागणारा कालावधी याबाबत स्पष्ट माहिती दिलेली नाही. दुखापती व्यवस्थापन कार्यक्रमापासून पुनर्वसनापर्यंत खेळाडूंना गुंतागुंतीच्या प्रक्रियेतून जावे लागत आहे.

दुखापती आणि पुनरागमन हा सगळा कार्यक्रम खेळाडूंनुसार बदलत जातो. मात्र, आतापर्यंत ‘सीओई’ खेळाडूंच्या पुनरागमनाचा अंदाजही देऊ शकलेले नाहीत. त्यांच्याकडून ‘क्लिनिकली फिट’ म्हणून खेळाडू तंदुरुस्त आहे, असा शिक्का दिला जातो. मात्र, तो स्पर्धात्मक क्रिकेटमध्ये पुनरागमनास तयार आहे का, हे यातून स्पष्ट होत नाही. ‘सीओई’चे

वैद्यकीय पथक खेळाडू पुन्हा कधी मैदानात परतू शकेल याबाबत स्पष्ट माहिती कधीच देत नाही. त्यामुळे बरेच प्रश्न निर्माण होतात,’’ असे सूत्रांकडून सांगण्यात आले. १४५ किमीहून अधिकच्या गतीने गोलंदाजी करणाऱ्या मयांक यादवचे कंबरचे स्नायू ताणले गेले. त्याला एप्रिल ते ऑक्टोबर २०२४ असे सहा महिने विश्रांती सांगण्यात आली. त्यानंतर तो अखेरचा सामना १२ ऑक्टोबर रोजी खेळला आणि गेल्या पाच महिन्यांपासून पाठीच्या दुखापतीमुळे तो मैदानाबाहेर आहे. या वेळी तो ‘आयपीएल’चे सुरुवातीचे सामने खेळू शकणार नाही असे म्हटले जात आहे. मात्र, याबाबत स्पष्ट माहिती देण्यात आलेली नाही. त्यामुळेच पूर्वीचे ‘एनसीए’ आणि आताच्या ‘सीओई’च्या कार्यपद्धतीवर प्रश्न उपस्थित केला जात आहे.

‘आयपीएल’मध्ये लाळेच्या वापरास परवानगी ?
